Contract for Porcelain Doll Seed to Benefit Cancer Research

Grower also agrees to identify Porcelain Doll Pink Pumpkins at the point of sale with appropriate signs, stickers and bins, and to comply with other requirements and guidelines specified by the foundation, either directly or through information posted at www.pinkpumpkinpatch.org
